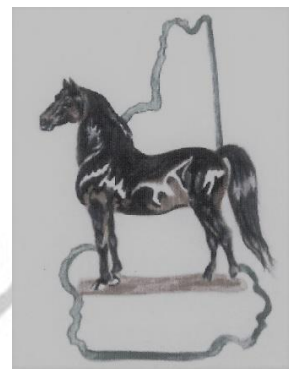

## **Rules & Regulations**

**ENTRIES CLOSE** June 5, 2021. A copy of Registration papers and lease agreement (if any) must accompany all entry blanks. The show committee and/or Management reserve the right to decline any entry and to return fees before the opening of the show & to prohibit or remove any person from the show without being held liable for compensation. All Morgan horses exhibiting must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Assoc., Inc., The Canadian Morgan Horse Assoc., or the British Morgan Horse Society or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration.

**AMHA MEDAL CLASSES** Refer to USEF AMHA Medal class specifications outlined in Rules Mo164 and Mo167 -Mo172.

**ACADEMY DIVISION** open to all breeds: Morgan horses in this division may enter other classes at the show with a different rider. See Academy Division for complete rules.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** All horses must have a copy of a negative Coggins test for EIA dated within 6 months of the show. Foals may use the Coggins of dam. All horses must have a certificate to prove Eastern & Western Equine Encephalitis vaccination has been administered this year. Out of state horses require health certificate to enter state. All horses must have a certificate to prove Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations have been administered within the last six months.

**POST ENTRIES:** Entries postmarked later than June 5, 2021 will be assessed \$25 per horse (An entry consists of a horse being entered in one class). Entries received after July 1 will be assessed a fee of \$75 per horse. There will be no post entry fees charged at the show for regular or championship classes, if the horse was entered prior to post entry dates noted above. *Post entries will be accepted according to the hours posted in the Horse Show Office & must be made at least one session prior to the class.* Management reserves the right to decline a post

entry in the case that such an entry would make it necessary for the class to be split. In such cases the exhibitor may elect to be placed on a waiting list to be entered in case of a scratch of a previously entered horse.

**SCRATCHES:** A \$25 fee will be levied for each instance an entry fails to notify the Show Secretary of a scratch prior to the start of a class.

**ENTRY BLANK:** *The Management and staff take no responsibility for exhibitor errors.* Owners: please use an additional entry blank and sign again, if you have more horses or equitation riders than an entry form allows.

**NON-RATED NEHC & NHH&TA CLASSES** are designated with ♦ and \* respectively.

**PAYMENT:** All initial fees must be made with entries. The show office will not accept partial payments from more than one person per horse from individuals sharing expenses. A signed blank check will be accepted. Visa, Mastercard and American Express are the credit cards accepted. **There will be a \$50 handling charge for all returned checks & declined credit cards. There will be a \$50 fee charged for all accounts not settled at the show.** Any account not paid in full within 2 weeks of the end of the show will be reported to USEF & other affiliated organizations for appropriate action. See Rules common to all shows for more information.

**REFUNDS** will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's or doctor's certificate. No refunds on stall and camper fees after the closing date.

**EVERY CLASS** offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the NEHC will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

**HEADERS & TAILERS** must be at least 16 yrs. old  
**CROSS ENTRIES** are allowed between Classic Pleasure, English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving Divisions. Cross entries are allowed between In Hand & Specialty In Hand. Horses entered in Tournament Division may be entered into any other class at the show with a different rider/driver.

**DENVER CLASSES:** Since the Seacoast show was not held in 2020, for each division with a Junior Horse or Jr. Exhibitor class, i.e., hunt, park, pleasure and western there will be a Denver designation added to those classes held for those that were Junior horses and Jr. Exhibitors in 2020. These Denver designation classes will be held for the year 2021 only.

**SHOW RING ATTIRE:** Exhibitors and attendants are required to observe proper show ring attire and decorum. No shorts, jeans or open toed shoes. Any person not properly attired shall be excused from the show ring. **Helmets approved for horseback riding (not bicycle helmets) are encouraged for all exhibitors and are mandatory for Lead Line & Tournament Classes.**

**MANAGEMENT** reserves the right to cancel or combine or split any class. Class changes will be posted in the Secretary's office.

**HOLDS** accepted at the discretion of Show Mgr.

**WARM UP AREA:** No long lining of horses on the grounds. Lunging is allowed in the warm-up area only when classes are not in session.

**PRIZE MONEY** will be awarded in the ring. Once the cash has been awarded the responsibility of the horse show will cease. Prize money for Breeder's Class prize money will be mailed following the show per program rules.

**QUALIFYING:** 1<sup>st</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> placings in Morgan classes qualify for the Morgan Grand National & World Championships.

**PRIZES:** Six ribbons & an award will be given in all classes, except for Jr. Exhibitor classes, which will have eight placings and an award.

**AWARDS:** Due to loss and damage, challenge Trophies will be used for presentation photo purposes in center ring. Winner will receive a plaque for their possession. Challenge Trophies will be awarded to the recipient only upon retirement of trophy.

Note: Prize money will not be awarded in classes with only one entry.

**\*\$3,500 STAKE CLASSES** receive Champion level ribbon, winner receives \$2,500, and then a random drawing will result in two entries who complete the class to receive \$500, minus the winner.

**\$250 Scholarship** – For the equitation classes only. Winning exhibitor is eligible for \$250 towards college education.

**STABLING:** Box stalls with doors. Horse Stalls/Tack Stalls \$135 **STABLING MANAGER:** Tuffy Owens 602-579-3738. **Any stabling changes from original information on entry blank must be made the Show Secretary** to ensure proper billing. Any person requesting additional stalls for another person after receipt of original signed entry blank assumes responsibility for added stalls. All stalls reserved must be paid for even, if not used. If necessary, tack stalls may be limited.

**FOOD SERVICE & TACK SHOP** on grounds.

**ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURES:** Grounds will be open to exhibitors from Tuesday, July 6<sup>th</sup>, at 8am to Sunday at 12 noon. Early arrivals or late departures must contact Tuffy Owens at 602-579-3738. Additional daily fees of \$20 per stall apply.

**HAY & SHAVINGS** will be available on the grounds & must be paid directly to vendor. Availability hours will be posted. Contact Tuffy Owens, 602-579-3738 to pre-order by July 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**DOGS:** Leash and clean up after all dogs. It is required that all animals on the grounds be vaccinated against Rabies. There is a \$50 fine for loose dogs, payable to Deerfield Fairgrounds.

**CAMPER/TENT PARKING** with/without electricity & water \$185. Early Arrivals: \$30 per day \$100 fine for dumping grey water anywhere on the grounds. Pumping is available.

**SHOW RING (190' x 100') FOOTING** is stone dust and sand. Warm-up arena (150' x 80') with stone dust and sand footing is available.

**OFFICE & HOSPITALITY:** Information regarding stall locations, grounds facilities, etc. will be available at the Horse Show office. Messages may be left there & will be promptly relayed. Show office phone is 602-579-3738. Coffee and doughnuts served each morning.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm-utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry form as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized

vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition, and charges being filed against any of the above individuals. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

THE SEACOAST MORGAN HORSE SHOW, show committee, its agents & employees will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendant, spectator, animal or equipment at the show. Nor will the SEACOAST MORGAN HORSE SHOW, show committee, its agents & employees be held responsible for loss or destruction of any property or equipment, damages to or by animals on the Deerfield Fairgrounds.

### In Hand Division

Entries are to be judged individually, standing then at a walk & trot on the line & must be serviceably sound. Horses should stand with front legs perpendicular to the ground. Rear legs may be placed slightly back. The horse is also judged during the class not stretched. Emphasis is placed on type and conformation with consideration given to horse's ability to move correctly on the lead. Unnatural tail carriage should be penalized. Not more than two handlers shall be allowed in the ring to show each horse in In Hand classes. No item may be used inside or outside the ring while showing the horse except one whip per handler. There is only one standard for type and conformation for the Morgan horse.

#### **\$3,500 Breeder's Division** ♦ \*

These classes are open to all Registered Morgans (or eligible for registration). There are no nomination fees or other restrictions. All registered Morgan Weanlings, Yearlings and for 2021 only, Two Year Olds, who eligible for registration are invited. Exhibitors are required to wear proper evening attire.

To be judged according to current USEF rules for Morgan In Hand. Entries will first be judged individually. The top ten entries will be called back for final evaluation as a group.

#### **Complete rules are available at the show or mailed upon request.**

Prize money for Breeder's Division will be mailed following the show within 30 days. After any prize money is awarded, the responsibility of the Maine Morgan Breeder's Cup will cease. Entries close at show closing date, however post entries are allowed. Entries made after close of the office Thursday morning are not guaranteed to be listed in the Breeder's Class program. Order of go will be posted in the Secretary's Office Friday afternoon. Any entry made after the order of go is posted will be the first entry to show.

Must be won three times by the same horse for permanent possession.

### Amateur Owned, Trained & Shown Division ♦ \*

**Entry Fee: \$30 class**

Exhibitors, attendants, and headers must meet the specifications for Amateur status, GR1306. Horses are not to have been professionally

trained during the current competition year (riding and driving instruction excluded). In addition, horses are not to be presented, prepared, groomed or schooled with the aid of a professional before or during the competition. Horses may be stabled with a professional during the competition and hauled by a professional. Professional help for situations relevant to safety is permitted.

Owner must sign as owner, trainer & rider/driver on the entry form, will be strictly enforced. For definition of amateur owner, refer to MO104.9. All AOTS saddle classes qualify exhibitors for the respective Amateur Championship.
