For over six decades the Connecticut Morgan Open Horse Show has been home to horses that thrill! In the spring of 2020, we faced the difficult reality that, "the show doesn't always go on." COVID-19 presented an incredible amount of uncertainty for not just CMHA but for our entire community. Down but not out for the count, our board shifted our programming to engage fellow equestrians across the country. We hosted virtual people's choice awards, stick horse contests, dog shows, trail rides, and youth contests. Our members created COVID-19 care packages that were distributed to over 200 front-line equine professionals across breeds, borders, and disciplines.

As 2020 came to a close and we cautiously began planning, our mantra became "We're ready for this, there's no denying!" IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

ENTRIES CLOSE: May 3, 2022

All entries postmarked after May 3, 2022, will be subject to a late fee of \$30.00 per horse. Entries not received on or after May 22, 2022, will be charged a late fee of \$45.00. Please note, these late charges will be enforced for everyone.

Entry, drug, and stall fees must be paid in full at the time of entry and accompany the entry form. **FAXED OR EMAILED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** During the show, for horses that are already entered, post entries must be made one session prior to the class being entered. No splitting of fees on any entry blank. In the event of a cancellation necessitated by severe weather or other emergency, entry fees will not be refunded. The term "entry" may not be used when an owner qualifies more than one horse in a championship class. Enter one horse that might be shown and you may make a substitution with another qualified entry at no charge.

MORGAN ENTRIES: Horses in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association Inc., the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society, and must be entered under their full registered name or if under one year of age, be eligible for registration. Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or lessee or record with the AMHA, CMHA, or BMHS. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of a lease must be submitted with the entry form at the time of making the entry. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement. Owners, trainers, and riders must be members of AMHA. No stripping in any championship classes.

FRIESIAN ENTRIES: Individuals signing the USEF Entry Agreement (i.e. rider, driver, handler, an agent of an owner, and trainer) for horses competing in the Friesian division must be members of the International Friesian Show Horse Association or pay a non-member fee to IFSHA for each competition. All Friesian horses competing in Friesian classes must have an IFSHA number not just Friesian registration papers.

ACADEMY ENTRIES: Riders in this division are students who are currently taking lessons and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. The age of the rider must be listed on the entry blank. Headers for lead line riders must be at least 18 years of age. Horses that are used are to be lesson horses (see horse eligibility). Horses are not to be judged. Class splits will be made at the manager's discretion. There will be minimum holds allowed. Please be prepared to enter the ring when the class is called. A rider may not enter in any other division at the show. A rider who has shown in a regular division or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from participating further in the Academy Division, with the exception of the Show Rider Classes. Once a rider has competed at any level wearing a full suit, they are ineligible to compete in academy classes at any point thereafter; the rider can however show in Show Rider Classes in the season(s) following the season in which the rider showed wearing a full suit.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

ACADEMY RIDER ATTIRE: Helmets approved for horseback riding (no bicycle helmets) are mandatory for all exhibitors. Riders must wear appropriate boots. Saddle Seat – Kentucky jodhpurs, boots, shirt, and vest. No full saddle suits are allowed. Hunt Seat – Breeches, boots, and hunt shirt. No coats allowed. Western Seat – Western jeans or slim-fitting pants, long sleeve shirt with a tie. Pelham bridles, or full bridles may be used (martingales allowed). There are no shoeing restrictions or requirements. Protective boots are allowed. Braiding is optional. Classes will be divided between seats if entries warrant. If it becomes necessary to split classes into A and B sections due to shared horses, Section A of both classes will be run consecutively, then Section B, to reduce tack and rider changes.

ACADEMY HORSE ELIGIBILITY: All horses/ponies used in Academy classes must be used regularly in lesson programs. All breeds are welcome. Horses used in Tournament classes can cross enter into the regular horse show classes with different riders.

YOUTH CONTEST ELIGIBILITY: The winner of the senior division AND all senior contestants to score over 800 points qualify to compete in the youth contest at the Grand National & World Championship Morgan Horse Show®. A contestant that has qualified to compete at the Nationals MUST have completed their Sherman badge BEFORE the time of the National contest. Senior contestants can only win ONE youth of the year contest per year. The same contestant can compete in all four divisions of another contest but CANNOT place overall. If only one contestant is entered in a contest, they MUST score over 700 points to qualify for the Grand National Youth of the Year Contest. Contestants must complete all four parts (Horsemanship, Judging, Written Test, and the Oral Presentation) of the contest in order to qualify for an overall award.

CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: Exhibitors must enter and show in the respective section for each championship. Cross entering is allowed between the Classic Pleasure and English Pleasure Divisions and Classic Pleasure Driving and Pleasure Driving Division if shoeing requirements are met.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Award trophy and eight ribbons and prize money as noted.

LIMIT RIDER CLASSES: All entries in limit rider classes will be eligible to show back in either their respective limit rider or age group championship.

LADIES CLASSES: All entries in ladies' classes will be eligible to show back in their respective amateur championship if they were qualified by an amateur.

MEMORIAL TROPHIES All memorial trophies are presented in each class, awards MUST be returned to the show committee by the end of the show. Awards not returned will result in a \$250 fine added to your show bill.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

STABLING: 620 permanent stalls with doors are available. Show management cannot guarantee the same stall location from year to year. There will be no additional stabling. Due to the stabling limitations, early entries are advised. No initial bedding provided.

HORSE STALL FEES: \$145.00

TACK STALL FEES: \$145.00

SHAVINGS: \$TBD per bag

ENTRY FEES: All qualifying classes are \$40.00 and all Championship classes are \$55.00.

SHOW PASS FEE: \$45.00 not available to those showing amateur – amateurs MUST be a member.

BOX SEAT FEES: Will be available during the entire course of the show at the rate of \$125.00 for six (6) seats.

NON-SHOWING HORSE FEE: There is a \$55.00 charge per horse for horses that are stabled on the grounds and not entered and shown in any classes. This fee is in addition to stall fees.

USEF FEE: Every horse participating shall pay a \$23.00 Federation fee (\$15.00 shall be the equine drugs and medications fee).

RETURNED CHECK FEE: There will be a \$50.00 handling charge for all returned checks and/or declined credit cards.

BILLING FEE: A \$25.00 fee will be charged to any exhibitor or farm who must be billed after the show.

SCRATCHES: An exhibitor failing to scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the session in which the class is scheduled will be assessed a \$25 scratch fee. All scratches must be made on the official scratch form and signed by the secretary. Money for qualifying classes is not refunded but may be put toward another class. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine or split any class. Class changes will be posted in the Secretary's office.

ADDING CLASSES: Please note that Management will not consider adding any classes to the schedule without a minimum guarantee of three entries to show in the class and a sponsorship of \$100 which must be paid prior to the added class.

REFUNDS: Refund request made before the closing date of entries; May 3, 2022, will be made in full. Entry fees will be refunded due to an injury/casualty to a horse or exhibitor, or an immediate member of the exhibitor's family only when the exhibitor provides the show secretary with a veterinarian or doctor's certificate no later than the start of the show. Stall fees and office fees will not be refunded for any reason after the close of entries on May 3, 2022.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

US EQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach, or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45.00 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule: 1) leadline 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

SAFE SPORT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

FIRE & SAFETY REGULATIONS: The following regulations must be adhered to in accordance with the Town of the West Springfield Fire Regulations and Public Safety Code:

1. No smoking allowed in the barns or the Coliseum.
2. No open flames allowed in any building.
3. All fabrics used as backdrops and/or display must be flame retardant.
4. Burlap material is not allowed for display.
5. Bark mulch is not allowed for display material.
6. Large wood chips or coarse bark mulch may be used in barns but shall be kept damp at all times.
7. No motorized gasoline/diesel vehicles.
8. All exits and fire lanes shall remain free and clear at all times.
9. No excessive accumulation of litter or rubbish.
10. All aisles shall be a minimum of 10" in length
11. Aisle display widths are not to exceed: two feet
12. Main aisles 30" from each side
13. Side aisles 24" from each side
14. All children 12 years of age and under must wear a helmet while riding a bicycle
15. No rollerblading or skateboarding.
16. No glass bottles or containers.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

FOOTING: The coliseum show arena is 100' x 200' and is sand footing. The warm-up footing is sand or grass.

LUNGING: Horses are not permitted to be lunged in the coliseum.

QUIET TIME: There will "quiet time" in the Coliseum the first hour after the conclusion of each afternoon session. We ask that exhibitors and trainers respect the quiet time.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: In accordance with USEF GR901.29; Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HORSE ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: The grounds will be open to exhibitors and horses from 9:00 A.M. on Monday, June 6, 2022 until Sunday, June 12, 2022.

CAMPER ARRIVALS: Campers or horse trailers with living quarters will be parked in the area designated by the management. Camper stickers will be issued at the gate by the Eastern States. The fee to be paid at the show office is \$245.00 for Monday, June 6, 2022, through Sunday, June 12, 2022; \$330 for campers requiring 50-amp service. Early arrival campers can move in on Sunday, June 1st, 2020 but must pay a \$20 per night early arrival fee at the gate; \$50.00 per night for 50- amp service. Fees are paid at the show office, except for \$20.00 early fees, which be collected at the gate for Sunday arrivals.

Take I-91 North from Rte. 2, I-84, I-95, or the Merritt Parkway — Follow I-91 North to Mass. Exit 3 to Route 5 North to Rte. 147 West, Memorial Avenue approximately 3/4 mi. to ESE's Gate 9 parking lot.

FROM BRADLEY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Take Rte. 75 North to Rte. 147 East. Continue approximately 1/2 mile to ESE's Gate 9 parking lot.

FROM VERMONT AND POINTS NORTH

Take I-91 South to Mass. Exit 13B, to Rte. 5 South, to Rte. 147 West. Continue approximately 3/4 mi. to ESE's Gate 9 public parking lot.

FROM THE BERKSHIRES AND POINTS WEST



We will continue to comply with local, state, and national regulations. We comply with all USEF COVID-19 recommendations. DOGS: Dogs are welcome to attend the 2022 edition of the Connecticut Morgan Open Horse Show. DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES. Unleashed dogs pose a danger to the safety of our exhibitors, spectators, and other dogs.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

COVID-19 Protocol: Masks are mandatory except in camper areas. Eastern States Exposition is committed to providing an exceptional experience, which begins by ensuring the health and safety of our guests, promoters, exhibitors, vendors and employees. We are closely monitoring Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, federal, state and local government mandates and public health advancements and will continue to make changes as necessary or appropriate to our protocols and procedures.

Cleaning Protocol:

1. The frequency of cleaning and disinfecting has been increased in all public spaces including an emphasis on frequent contact surfaces to be wiped and sanitized in show buildings prior to show move-in, prior to public entry and frequently throughout the show. Restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected before and during each show. During an event, male and female cleaning service staff are on hand and throughout day will clean surfaces, floors, handles, toilets and sinks and stock supplies in buildings and restrooms. Trash receptacles are washed and disinfected in preparation for every event.
2. A Victory electrostatic cordless sprayer will be used to sanitize and disinfect surfaces throughout the building continuously while the show is open, focusing on door handles inside and out, counter tops, lids of trash barrels, and ATMs.
3. Buildings will have hand sanitizer stations placed in key areas for guests. Visitors are encouraged to wash hands often, and signage in restrooms, entrances and other areas and public address announcements will serve as a reminder throughout the show. Hand sanitizer will be available for ticket sellers and entry personnel.
4. There will be health and hygiene reminders throughout building including bathrooms.
5. Cleaning products, which meet EPA guidelines and are approved for use effectively against viruses, bacteria, and other airborne pathogens, will be used.
6. Show offices will be thoroughly cleaned prior to move-in dates. Promoters will be given disinfectant supplies for their use on desks and counters.
7. The frequency of air filter replacement and HVAC cleaning has been increased and the amount of air exchange will be maximized to increase external air flow into buildings.

Social Distancing

1. Ticket booths will have only one ticket seller. Dividers between the tickets sellers in the booths, as well as outside the booth will protect the attendees purchasing tickets.
2. Governor Baker issued an order requiring masks or cloth face coverings to be worn at all times regardless of social distance. This applies to both indoor and outdoor spaces. Children under the age of 6 are not required to wear a mask, it is encouraged for children ages 2-5 wear a mask or face covering, but not required. Exceptions include those unable to wear a mask or face covering due to a medical condition. ESE staff and event staff will monitor guests for compliance.

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

3. Upon entering ESE grounds, all individuals ages 5+ will be required to wear a mask or face covering at all times.
4. Wherever possible, we will utilize touchless payment systems. Wherever possible, guests are encouraged to purchase tickets online and/or in advance. Wherever possible, we will place plexiglass or other types of barriers/hygiene screens between guests and employees/show staff.
5. Every aspect of attending ESE shows and events will utilize social distancing measures. Lines for the purchase of tickets, food and beverage, booth spacing, seminars, guest appearances, rides and attractions and commerce will provide distancing requirements of six ft. or greater. Lines may not inhibit emergency exits or encroach on other queue lines.
6. Building capacities for commerce and educational viewing will be reduced to current guidelines.

Show Manager Responsibilities

All show staff, volunteers, exhibitors, and attendees are required to participate in a daily self-certification confirming they are not experiencing COVID-19-related CDC-defined symptoms prior to entering Eastern States Exposition. Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms should report to their supervisor immediately. Supervisors should contact their event coordinator and notify Cliff Hedges, director of Public Safety and Security, immediately.

1. Provide a plan to obtain contact information for all staff, volunteers, exhibitors and attendees for contact tracing purposes.
2. All events are expected to abide by their specific trade industry requirements.
3. Government advised 6ft social distancing spacing.
4. Maintain 6ft social distance in all work areas and offices.
5. Governor Baker issued an order requiring masks or cloth face coverings to be worn at all times regardless of social distance. This applies to both indoor and outdoor spaces. Children under the age of 6 are not required to wear a mask, it is encouraged for children ages 2-5 wear a mask or face covering, but not required. Exceptions include those unable to wear a mask or face covering due to a medical condition. ESE staff and event staff will monitor guests for compliance.
6. Wash hands or hand sanitize 4 x per hour, and wash hands before each meal and after each use of bathroom, sneeze, cough, touch of face, blowing of nose or smoking.
7. Hand sanitizer should be an anti-microbial agent that kills or renders 99.9% of all known bacteria, viruses, and fungi that are present on surfaces. (Hand sanitizers must contain at least 60% alcohol.)

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

8. Hand sanitizer provided by ESE in stationary units.
9. Hand sanitizer is not provided for individual show staff/ vendors/exhibitors
10. Hand Sanitizer available at all work stations.
11. Maintain proper personal hygiene standards based on interaction with others, and consumable items.
12. Align with Federal, State, and Eastern States Exposition cleanliness
13. Posting of health and hygiene reminders in all office, retail vending and storage areas.
14. Posting of specific event guidelines in office, entrance points, and throughout the event.
15. Sales and Office staff required to sanitize hands in transaction situations.
16. Use of protective plastic shield recommended for all counter transactions.
17. Deep cleaning and sanitation of counters, registers, and customer service devices on a daily basis, including writing implements, pens and pencils.
18. Restrict show office access to essential personnel only, configure the space and limit the number of office staff to comply with social distancing, and limit the number of participants who can enter the show office at one time (e.g., schedule check-in/check-out times).
19. Use exterior windows when possible and monitor the number of people within the office at one time.
20. Monitor spacing in queue lines for show offices and all vending areas and floor markings.
21. Recommended to accommodate pre-registration and check-in when possible or available online option.
22. Align with Eastern States Exposition disinfecting policies in all areas.
23. All retail vending and bank related items to be sanitized daily.

Food/Beverage/Vendors

Self-serve, buffet style food is prohibited -- including but not limited to: Hospitality areas, food provided for committee members, judges and office staff.

1. Self-serve drink is permitted, with the following guidelines:
2. Hand sanitizer must be made available next to beverage stations and operators must instruct customers to use before pouring beverages.
3. Only straws and stirrers individually wrapped in cellophane or paper allowed.
4. Cups and lids must be from single pull dispenser or other method to minimize contact.
5. Sweetners, sugars and creamers must be individual packets.
6. Floor markers must be installed to achieve social distancing
7. Use of personal mugs and cups are not allowed.
8. Frequent disinfecting of the beverage station must take place, even during busy times.
9. Self serve condiment dispensers are prohibited.
10. Self-serve utensil, napkin and straw dispensers are prohibited.
11. Seating areas will adhere to social distancing, tables and chairs must be cleaned and sanitized thoroughly between each seating

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- 12.Limit decorations around event.
- 13.Group dining must adhere to all social distancing guidelines and cleaning protocols.
- 14.Maintain proper personal hygiene standards based on interaction with others, and consumable items.
- 15.No sampling of consumable products.
- 16.Vendors must offer hand sanitizer at transaction areas.
- 17.All vendors are recommended to offer credit and debit card machines.
- 18.Vendors should monitor number of attendees within exhibit space.
- 19.Deep cleaning and sanitation of entire food service area, including counters, registers, and customer service devices on a daily basis, including writing implements, pens and pencils.
- 20.Establish protocol for high customer touch areas.
- 21.Monitor queue lines for adherence for social distancing guidelines.
- 22.All retail vending and bank related items to be sanitized daily.

ESE Event Guidelines

SCreate an Emergency Response Plan specific to a COVID-19 incident or outbreak that includes local medical resources and addresses outbreak protocols including medical evaluation, isolation and quarantine, and reporting. Include directions on how to handle a case on the grounds during an event.

- 1.Provide training for staff, volunteers and licensed officials regarding all procedures and requirements associated with the Plan.
- 2.Ensure vendors and service providers are included in the communication and training requirements associated with the Plan.
- 3.Disseminate a copy of the Plan to all applicable personnel.
- 4.Anyone experiencing COVID-19-related symptoms in the past 14 days or currently under home quarantine or self-monitoring are not permitted to attend ESE events.
- 5.If you feel sick: Alert First Aid or ESE staff. First Aid is clearly marked in each building.
- 6.If a COVID-19 incident or outbreak occurs, all participants and staff must be notified. Contact Cliff Hedges, director of Public Safety and Security, immediately.
- 7.Notify all participants, staff, and appropriate personnel if a person who was present on the grounds tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of event.
- 8.Post signage at all entrances which identify the symptoms of COVID-19 and states proper hygiene practices.
- 9.Provide signage throughout event stating: To protect others from possible transmission of the virus, anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks, cannot enter the grounds. With the exception of if you have received two doses of the Moderna or Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines or one dose of the Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)

IMPORTANT EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

10. Provide clear floor markings stating flow of foot traffic and 6 ft. required spacing when in line. ESE must approve floor markings before placement.
11. Configure stabling/grooming areas/exhibit space to comply with social distancing requirements.
12. Required to provide ESE with refund and cancellation policy.
13. ESE reserves the right to remove anyone from the grounds displaying COVID-19 symptoms.
14. Check in and waiver requirements must align with those of ESE.
15. COVID plan must include waivers and thorough check-in process.

Agricultural Event Guidelines

All exhibitors must provide a waiver to the show manager.

1. Consider utilizing technology for information transfer to mitigate the risk of virus spread.
2. Create a method of giving ribbons and trophies that reduces or eliminates hand-to-hand contact.
3. Any staff member with an underlying health issue will be encouraged not to join us this year unless fully vaccinated.
4. There can be no more than one person on a golf cart unless the other is a member of the same pod or sitting on the tailgate. Those delivering agricultural feed products are exempt but must wear a mask or face covering.
5. There will be no food preparation allowed in the barns by exhibitors.
6. No sleeping in Mallary Complex.
7. All exhibits will be separated by a space as required at event time. The separation space may not be used for tack space.
8. Breed and exhibitor meetings limited to one representative per farm, and held in space large enough to maintain social distancing.
9. Limit number of animals in show ring and warm-up ring at any one time and space them out. Show managers to break large classes into smaller heats.
10. Judge and ring steward are required to wear a mask and maintain 6 ft. social distancing with exhibitor. Microphone is reserved for judge's use and sanitized between shows.
11. Official photographer only for ring photos. Other photographers allowed ringside and must maintain social distance. Videographer for live stream maintains separate table and operates camera remotely. Only handler, judge and queen/award presenter allowed in backdrop photo with animal, spaced appropriately. Limit number of animals waiting for photos, spaced appropriately.
12. Spectators must maintain appropriate distance at ringside, no leaning on fence or crowding entry/exit points. Space to be marked/outlined around ring and in bleachers. Limit number of spectators at ringside in order to maintain distance, using staff at doors if necessary.
13. Staff and announcer table remains at ringside, with appropriate social distancing. Showers will only be available when agreed-upon cleaning measures and schedules are acceptable.
