Youth of the Year contests are designed to recognize youth who learn about the versatility of the Morgan Horse and the and are well-versed in horsemanship skills. The contest consists of four parts: a written exam, an oral presentation, a judging contest and a horsemanship pattern. Each section of the contest is worth 250 points. We will offer divisions for Lead line, Walk/Trot, Junior and Senior. Each of the four parts will receive ribbons and then overall high scores. The Senior division winner will receive a scholarship to help towards costs of competing at The Morgan Grand National in October. Any other Senior who receives a score of 800 or above also qualifies to attend.

Contest Parts:

- 1. The general knowledge test will be on line, so you will need to bring a laptop with you.
- 2. The Judging contest will consist of three classes and Oral Reasons.
- 3. Horsemanship pattern will be done via video and should be done on a Morgan to a prescribed pattern.
- 4. Oral Presentation is to be 3-5 minutes in length and the topics will be given as we get closer to the show. Posters, etc are encouraged.
