Entries close May 1, 2025

Entries postmarked after May 1, 2025 will be charged a post entry fee of **\$20.00 per horse**. **Entry and stall fees must accompany Entry Blanks.** Absolutely no stalls will be reserved until payment has been received. **Stall Fee is \$195.00.** Stalls will be available **AFTER 12:00 pm on Monday May 12, 2025 NOT BEFORE.**

NO HORSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ARRIVE ON THE GROUNDS AND SET UP OF STALLS BEFORE 12:00 PM ON MONDAY MAY 12, 2025

CAMPERS: may arrive 12:00pm or after on Monday May 12, 2025.

Camper hookups with water and electricity are available at a charge of \$375.00.

Trailers used as campers will be charged \$375.00

Stalls are not refundable after closing date

In all classes for registered horses only, the proper registered name and number must be listed on the entry form. The proper owner listed on the entry form. Also include a copy of the registration papers with entries.

Add or scratch entries must be made before the close of the previous session.

Entries wishing to be stabled together must indicate so on each individual's stabling list.

NO SMOKING in the barns.

The horse show committee reserves the right to change/add any official without notification.

This horse show reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class where it is deemed advisable and to reschedule any divided class. A class may be cancelled due to insufficient entries.

Entries made payable to Greater Boston Charity Horse Show.

Office fee \$25.00 per horse. There is a \$25 charge to exhibitors who fail to pay their fees before leaving the show, including exhibitors who have a check on file. There will be a \$30 charge for non-negotiable checks. Entry fees are only refundable with a veterinarian certificate.

Heath Requirements : The Dept. of Public Health requires that all horses provide a copy of a 2024 negative Coggins test for E.I.A. for out-of state horses: 24 months for Mass. horses and a certificate to prove the Eastern and Western Equine Encephalitis vaccination has been administered.

All Horses will be required to have a Health Certificate dated within 30 days of the Horse Show.

The Greater Boston Charity Horse Show all horse show officials, committee members or employees will not be responsible for any legal proceedings or liabilities from any such accident or loss of property caused to or by the property or employees of such exhibitor.

The GBCHS reserves the right to return any entry/entrance fee before the opening of the show without being liable for compensation.

Holds will be granted at the discretion of the paddock master and/or Show Chairman. These must be requested before the start of each session. We will try to cooperate with an exhibitor requesting a hold, but will not be responsible if a hold is not honored. If a hold is granted, the in-gate will be held for two minutes, then open for two minutes before the class is closed. No classes will be stripped. No person will be allowed in the ring except the required ones. No person shall approach a Judge unless first obtaining permission from the Show Steward. The Steward will not permit any exhibitor or trainer to speak with the Judge until the horse or rider in question has completed its last class of the show. Any exhibitor disregarding this rule will be asked to cancel all entries and forfeit entry fees.

DOGS must be on a leash. A \$50 fine will be charged for the return of any dog found loose on the show grounds. Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs.

FIRE REGULATIONS

- The use of two wire extension cords (ZIP cords) will no longer be allowed on the fairgrounds as they are deemed unsafe in agricultural settings. All extension cords must be GROUNDED (3wire/prong) cords. All appliances (ie. fans, clippers, etc.), must have a UL approved label attached. It is recommended that old fans with ungrounded cords be replaced with fans that have 3 wire grounded cords.
- NO SMOKING will be permitted in Arena or Livestock area (BARNs).
- Parking—Exits and entrances must be kept clear. Designated fire lanes must be kept clear. Any vehicles parked in unauthorized areas will be towed and charged at the owner's expense.
- No motorized vehicles are allowed in the buildings with the exception of golf carts for special circumstances and motorized wheelchairs.
- Aisle: Blocking of barn aisles is strictly prohibited. This includes drapes or other obstructions and may be removed by Management.

Take I- 91 North in Massachusetts to Northampton, Exit 25 (old Exit 19). Take Exit 25 and follow rotary onto Route 9 West (Bridge Street). Continue straight on Route 9 West (Bridge Street) to first set of lights and turn left onto Old Ferry Road or continue to your second left onto Fair Street.

From the North (Vermont):

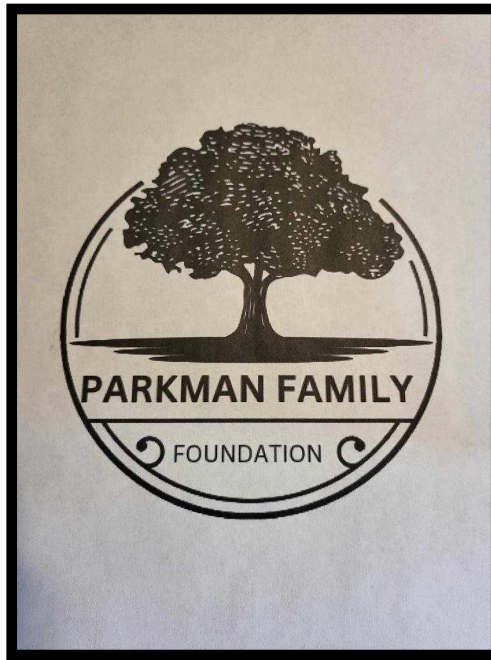
Take I-91 South to Exit 26 (old Exit 20) (US Route 5 South/N. King Street). As you come off the ramp and onto Route 5 South/N. King Street, merge into the left lane. Take a left turn at the traffic light onto Damon Road. Continue Damon Road for approx. 1 mile to the traffic circle/rotary. Merge into the rotary and bear right at the first turn off onto Route 9 West/Bridge Street. Continue along Route 9 West/Bridge Street for approx. 1/2 mile to Fair Street. Turn left onto Fair Street.

****We are in desperate need of a way to promote the cultivation of hunters and I feel this would be an exciting concept to get young hunters and professionals in the ring to market them and bring more value to our hunt division.****

Classes will be held at shows throughout the calendar year. The class will be called The Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge open to **American Saddlebred** horses 4 and under and shown by an Amateur or professional. Each class throughout the year will be a \$350 class with the entry fee for each class being \$50 which will be added back in to the class payout. Sunrise Stables will provide the class sponsorship, ribbons and trophies for each class (if outside sponsorship can be obtained for these classes it is encouraged). Each show will be responsible for paying out the prize money. Payouts will be 40%,20%,15%, 10%, 10%, 5% for each class. If less than 6 horses are in the class money not paid out will be divided evenly amongst ribbon winners.

Class points will be tabulated throughout the year using the Saddle Horse Report Point System. The final show of the year will be the Ocala International Horse Show. The high point winners will be announced after the class is completed. If the winners are in attendance they will be recognized. The payouts and awards will be sent to all those not in attendance. Sunrise Stables will provide the sponsorship of \$5000 with additional prize money being added from sponsors and additional prizes. **Freedman Harness** will award the high point winner a Freedman Hunt Bridle and **Saddle Horse Report** will award the 1st and 2nd place high point winner a full page ad. Payouts will be 40%, 20%, 15%, 10%,10%, 5%. Additional sponsors and prizes will be added.

In addition, each high point winner of their region will receive awards and recognition. The regions are as follows:

ACADEMY RULES

**HELMETS APPROVED FOR HORSEBACK RIDING ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL ACADEMY EXHIBITORS AND ALL RIDERS
MUST WEAR APPROPRIATE BOOTS. (No bicycle helmets)**

Saddle Seat Attire: KY Jods, boots, shirt and tie, Vest and gloves are optional. Sweaters, sweatshirts and turtlenecks that do not carry a farm name or logo are permissible in cold weather. No riding coats or derbies. Hunt Seat Attire: Hunter style Jods and boots. Shirt and tie or choker. No riding coats. Sweaters sweatshirts and turtlenecks that do not carry a farm name or logo are permissible in cold weather Western Seat Attire: Western jeans, long sleeve shirt, ties and chaps are optional, No western hats.

Mount must be a horse that is regularly used in a lesson program. Braiding is optional. There are not shoeing restrictions. Protective boots are permissible. Horses may cross enter from the regular horse show to academy classes provided these horses are in fact school horses.

Definition of a school horse: A horse who is used to teach a number of different riders in any given week, and whose temperament and manners are suitable for a novice rider. The Quality of the animal has no bearing on his eligibility.

Snaffle bridles and full bridles may be used. No neckties on horses.

Riders may not cross enter between divisions (a rider may show in either walk-trot or walk-trot-canter, but not both) A lead line rider may not show off the lead at the same show.

Headers for lead line riders must be at least 18 years of age.

Once a rider has shown off the lead, he/she may not return to lead line classes.

Once a rider has shown at the canter, he/she may not return to walk-trot classes.

In classes that require a posting trot, riders 6 & under shall not be judged on diagonals. "Open" refers to age, and classes may be split.

Once a rider has competed at any level wearing a full suit, they are ineligible to compete in academy classes at any point thereafter.
